

## **Report on significant event conducted – FEBRUARY 2020**

### **“Sustainable Income for Livestock farmers through fodder and disease management under changing climatic scenario” in Perambalur District.”**

The farming community is to be guided on alternative methods of animal husbandry activities like dairy cattle rearing, goat rearing and backyard poultry rearing and its disease management, fodder crops cultivation, etc. In this context, believers that it is right time to introduce fodder crops and alternate feed production such as silage making, preparation of azolla as a substitute cattle feed among the farmers. The proposed intervention by M/s. ICAR KVK Perambalur is anticipated to help the small and marginal farmers in increasing land and animal productivity with doubling farmers income. CAT – Programme started with three days (11-2-2020 to 13-2-2020) with two days of technical sessions handled by experts of our Institution and also from outside institution that includes Dairy, Cattle rearing, goat rearing, Poultry birds rearing, fodder crops production, silage production, Azolla production, etc. One day exposure visit for practical session handled to 30 farmers. On dairy cattle housing, feeding, and management. The sustainable animal husbandry practices promoted and followed by beneficiaries are expected to increase livestock productivity animal health and income as achieved with current dependent farming. These would create a larger impacts of this innovative ideas in sustainable income for livestock farmers through fodder and disease management under changing climatic scenario conducted made a grand success and been appreciated by the participants as well.
